MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

On September 25, 2014, the Court GRANTED Plaintiff's Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis ("IFP") pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and Granted Plaintiff Leave to file an Amended Complaint so that this Court could obtain more detail and review the matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B). (Document No. 4). On October 14, 2014, Plaintiff filed his Amended Complaint (Document No. 5).

The Court is required at this stage to apply a liberal review standard to the claims set forth in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint. Although not well organized or clearly articulated, the Amended Complaint at least minimally states a potentially plausible national origin discrimination claim. Without passing on the merits of the claim, Plaintiff's ultimate chance of prevailing or the merits of any defenses or immunities, the Court has determined that Plaintiff's claim against Brown University may proceed past the screening stage to service on Defendant.
