TO RENDER SERVICES TO THE DISTRICT**

The Honorable Mary M. Lisi, Senior District Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island, has informed Chief Judge John J. McConnell, Jr. that she is willing and able to perform the duties of district judge in the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island during the period beginning on June 15, 2020, and ending on December 31, 2020.

Judge Lisi will not be assigned any new cases. Rather, she will handle matters from time to time as determined by the Court.

Judge Lisi was nominated by President Bill Clinton on January 27, 1994 to a seat vacated by Judge Francis J. Boyle and received her commission on May 9, 1994. She served as the chief judge for the district from December 1, 2006 through November 30, 2013.

Judge Lisi received her law degree from the Temple University School of Law in 1977 and her bachelor's degree from the University of Rhode Island in 1972.
