<sup>2</sup> Staff vaccination totals reflect total staff vaccinated, some of whom are no longer employed by the Facility. The Facility is currently surveying its staff for confirmation of vaccination status and believes (based on confirmations and statements from staff) that approximately 101 of its current staff are vaccinated.
