
In accordance with the provisions of Rule 4(i)(1)(A)(i) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the United States Attorney respectfully advises the Court that, in addition to any duly-appointed Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Rhode Island, the following individuals are specifically authorized and designated to accept in-hand service upon the United States under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(i) for cases filed in this District:

- (1) the Legal Assistant to the Chief of the Civil Division for the Office of United States Attorney for the District of Rhode Island, who is designated as the Civil Process Clerk for this Office;
- (2) In the absence of the Civil Process Clerk, any other legal assistant or Paralegal Specialist assigned to the Civil Division of the Office of United States Attorney for the District of Rhode Island.

This designation is limited to service made at the Office of the U.S. Attorney, One Financial Plaza, 17th Floor, Providence, RI 02903. It does not waive any applicable defenses to adequacy of service, nor any requirement that service be made on another individual, entity, or party required to be served under Rule 4(i) or its subparts.
