CM/ECF MEDIA ACCESS TO CASES OF INTEREST

Members of the media may request to monitor particular civil and criminal non-sealed cases by signing up to receive automatic e-mail notifications of electronic filings (NEFs) made in specific civil and criminal non-sealed cases which they designate. Each NEF includes a hyperlink to the non-sealed, electronically filed document in the case.

Members of the media who register and are approved for this service can add or remove specific civil and criminal non-sealed cases to their account at any time. Members of the media must choose between receiving daily summary NEF e-mails that are sent at midnight or individual NEF e-mails that are sent when each particular document is filed.

Members of the media who are interested in registering for this service must complete the following steps:

- Register for a PACER account at http://www.pacer.psc.uscourts.gov. (PACER, which stands for Public Access to Court Electronic Records, is the federal judiciary's electronic public access service that allows users to obtain case and docket information from federal courts via the Internet.
- Register with the District of Rhode Island for CM/ECF Media Access by completing the Court's Media Registration for CM/ECF Access to Cases of Interest Form by clicking here.

Once your registration is approved, you will receive a confirmation e-mail from the Court which will include your login and password credentials. Members of the media are responsible to protect the security of their passwords and immediately notify the Clerk's Office if their password has been compromised.
