1 Minimum Technical Requirements

The Issuing Organization (IO), is seeking quotations for the purchase of the following:

Black Microsoft Surface Laptop 3 (PLZ-00022), - 15"- Core i7 1065G7U - Windows 10 Pro, 16GB RAM, 256GB SSD or EQUIVALENT.

Microsoft Surface Laptop Extended 4 Year Warranty Coverage (to include accidental damage coverage) or EQUIVALENT.

The IO requires that the tablet weigh no more than 3.4 lbs.

The IO requires that the tablet has a minimum battery life for up to 11.5 hours of web browsing.

The IO requires running desktop programs like Microsoft Office and Adobe DC for sending mail and creating documents. In addition, the IO requires running professional software such as Microsoft Edge, Chrome, Internet Explorer 11, Java, FlashPlayer 10, Cisco VPN, Symantec 14, Net Framework 3.0, Juniper, and ActiveX.

The IO requires running several desktop programs simultaneously such as Microsoft Edge and Chrome for multiple courts web based national applications including JIFMS, Jenie, and HRMIS. Also, local web-based applications court web-based applications which include I.T. Helpdesk, JMS, and CM/ECF.

In addition, the IO requires running software programs simultaneously for JICS, Java, Flash Player 10, Cisco VPN, Symantec 14, and Net Framework 3.5.
