NOTICE REGARDING MANDATORY ELECTRONIC FILING OF CIVIL COMPLAINTS

Effective December 15, 2014, and pursuant to LR Gen 303(a), the electronic filing of the following case initiation documents using the Court's Case Management/Electronic Case Files ("CM/ECF") system is mandatory for all attorneys absent an exemption from the Clerk's Office in accordance with LR Gen 302(a):

Civil complaint (*which must include a civil cover sheet*) Notice of removal (*which must include a civil cover sheet and the state court complaint*)

New civil cases that are to be sealed or filed by a *pro se* party must continue to be submitted in paper. Prior to electronically filing a case initiation document a Filing User must first:

- Complete the mandatory Electronic Learning Module (ELM) located at www.rid.uscourts.gov on the CM/ECF section of the Court's website. The lesson provides a step-by-step overview of how to electronically file a civil complaint or notice of removal. If desired, attorneys may also attend an in-person training session.
- **Review the Case Opening Instruction manual located at** www.rid.uscourts.gov on the CM/ECF section of the Court's website. The manual provides a detailed overview of the filing process as well as how to avoid common filing errors.

Upon the filing of a new civil case, a case number will be assigned by the system, and a presiding judicial officer will be assigned by the Clerk's Office. The Clerk's Office will electronically issue the service of process documents if a summons was included with the party's filing.
