**NOTICE REGARDING THE ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OF FEES FOR  
NOTICES OF APPEAL IN CIVIL CASES**

The United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island now accepts online credit card payments via Pay.gov from registered CM/ECF Filing Users for notices of appeal filed in civil cases. When electronically filing a notice of appeal in a civil case, the Filing User will automatically be directed to the Pay.gov online payment process. Upon successful completion of the online payment, the Filing User will automatically return to CM/ECF to complete the filing.

Pay.gov is a secure web-based application operated by the U.S. Treasury Department, which allows users to submit payments to government agencies electronically.
