NOTICE REGARDING ACCESS, SERVICE, AND MANAGEMENT OF SEALED DOCUMENTS

On September 18, 2025, the Court issued a general order outlining new procedures regarding the service, access, and management of sealed documents. Under these procedures, sealed documents will continue to be filed in CM/ECF under the Court's existing procedures. Since sealed documents filed in CM/ECF will no longer be accessible or viewable electronically, service of those documents must be made outside of CM/ECF as provided by the Federal Rules of Procedure and the Court's Local Rules. The Court will serve sealed orders and notices by secure electronic means or in paper by mail. A person authorized to view sealed documents can request a copy by contacting the Clerk's Office.
