NOTICE REGARDING PUBLIC ACCESS TO TRIAL PROCEEDINGS IN UNITED STATES OF AMERICA v. HULING

Beginning on June 7, 2021, and continuing for the duration of the trial in the case of *United States v. Huling*, the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island will provide public access to the trial in the following manner:

- 1. Members of the public or the media may request access to view the proceedings remotely by Zoom video conference. Requests for remote access can be sent to:

 RID_ECF_Intake@rid.uscourts.gov. A member of the Court staff will provide you with the Zoom Meeting ID/Passcode by email. Members of the public or the media viewing the proceedings remotely are reminded that recording, photographing, broadcasting, or otherwise transmitting Court proceedings are prohibited by LR Gen 112(a).
- 2. Members of the public or the media may appear at the Courthouse and view the proceedings by closed circuit video feed from the Court's overflow courtroom. Members of the public attending the proceedings at the Courthouse must comply with the provisions of the Court's Amended General Order Regarding Courthouse Visitation and Access Restrictions, dated May 30, 2021. The Court can accommodate 12 attendees in the overflow courtroom. Persons will be admitted on a first come, first serve basis, and no members of the public or the media will be permitted to enter the courthouse to observe the trial once the overflow courtroom reaches the 12-person maximum.
